# May 2, 2021 5<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter

In Christian tradition, Easter is not just a single day. It is at least a season - often called "Eastertide"- that stretches from the day itself to Pentecost Sunday some 50 days later. In an even deeper sense, every Sunday is a "little Easter" remembering and celebrating the core Christian affirmation of God's triumph of life over death. Indeed, in the very early days of the church, the regular time of Christian worship moved from the Sabbath of Jewish tradition to Sunday, at first in the evening as Sunday was a universal workday.
