Rockingham County Division of Public Health Proceeds to COVID-19 Vaccination Phase 1b “You Have a Spot, Take Your Shot”

Wentworth, NC – A tested, safe and effective vaccine will be available to all who want it, but supplies will be limited at first. Recently, the NC Department of Health and Human Services (NCDHHS), revised its Vaccine Prioritizations Recommendations. The Rockingham County Division of Public Health, will adhere to the updated recommended 4-Phase rollout plan. On January 12th, 2021, the Rockingham County Division of Public Health will begin Phase 1b of the NCDHHS Vaccine Prioritization Recommendation.

There is not enough vaccine for everyone in this phase to be vaccinated at the same time. Phase 1b will not be open to everyone at first. Vaccinations be given to individuals 75 years and older at this time.

The vaccine site will be established at the former Daymark Recovery (look for the big white tent). Patients will be observed for 15 minutes for signs of reaction after the injection is given. Include consent information. The schedule will be as follows:
