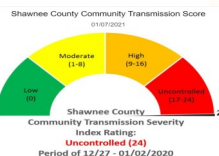
TIME TO PICK UP/DROP OFF:

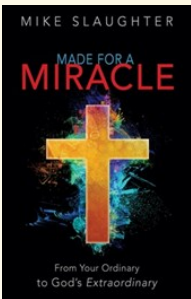

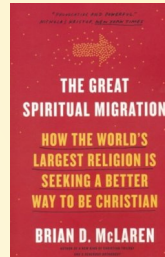
ADULT SUNDAY SCHOOL

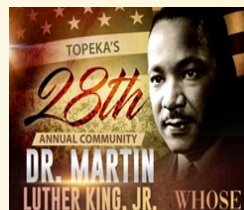

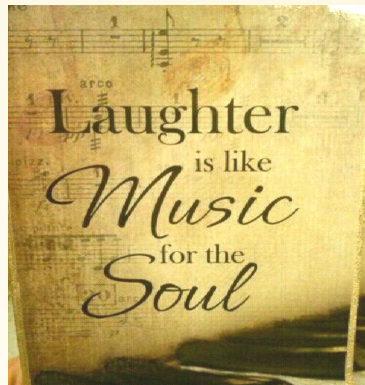
You can find this option on Trinity's website at www.trinitypresbyterian.net. Select the "Give" tab in the upper right portion of the screen and follow the instructions.
