REMINDER: We have returned to online worship only due to the current upsurge in Covid-19 cases across the state and our community. We hope you will join us this Sunday online.


The worship service will begin at 10:30 am. You will be able to access it either on Facebook or on the Trinity website.

The "Dear To My Heart" stewardship campaign for 2021 has come to a close with 97 pledges totaling \$382,016. For 2020, there were 101 pledges for a total of \$387,404.

In comparison to last year, thirty increased their pledge, fifty pledged the same, thirteen decreased their pledge, four were new pledges, six did not pledge, and two died or

moved away.

Trinity's justice ministry, Topeka JUMP, is in its research phase. Members are researching the new issue campaign, Mental Health/Addiction, and are also continuing to work on the issues of Affordable Housing, Predatory Lending and Transportation. The Violence Campaign, SAVE (Strategies Against Violence Everywhere), is in the maintenance phase. Earlier this year, JUMP got the County Commission put money in the 2021 budget to hire a project manager for SAVE and JUMP is pleased to report the County District Attorney's office has done so and the project manager will start work in January.


PHASE 2 IS IN EFFECT-COVID 19 VACCINEI
