
# PRESBYTERIAN DISASTER ASSISTANCE

Presbyterian Disaster Assistance (PDA) is the emergency and refugee program of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.). It enables our congregations and mission partners to witness to the healing love of Christ through caring for communities adversely affected by crisis and catastrophic event. In the first half of 2020 (1/1/20-6/30/20) PDA granted \$4.1 million as 487 grants in the United States and 57 countries. Of that, \$2.5 million was for COVID-19 response.
