Trinity's in-person worship services with our new live-streaming capabilities have been a success!

We, as Session, will continue to ensure everyone's health and safety by adhering to protocols recommended by the CDC and the Shawnee County Health Department. We prefer to observe strict protocols in order to protect those who have not been vaccinated and those who have fears and/or health vulnerabilities. As the CDC and other health authorities revise recommendations, we will also revise our own protocols when appropriate. Please refer to this Weekly E-Newsletter (Trinity Candle) for updates to our COVID-19 protocols.

Changes to the current Checklist include:

- 1) The restrooms will be open with a two-person capacity only. We strongly recommend hand washing and sanitizing after use.
- 2) Re-entry to the sanctuary will be permitted.
- 3) The Sanctuary doors will close five minutes before the service to buffer the noise level in the narthex and lobby for live-streaming.
- 4) Ushers will maintain flexibility in seating congregants based on capacity and attendance.

Because our HVAC (heating and air-conditioning) system recycles the air in the building, we are not comfortable singing at this time. However, future plans include congregational singing (with masks) when conditions allow for this change.

- Masks are still required. Social distancing will continue to be observed.
- Nursery, office, parlor, kitchen, basement and water fountains remain closed.

On April 26th, Trinity's justice ministry held its Nehemiah Assembly. Even though it was a virtual assembly, 1,361 people turned out. This was our largest assembly ever! Trinity had 106 people in attendance. YEAH!!! That is the most we have ever had!

At the assembly, Friends of Recovery Association and KDADS agreed to advocate for \$261,000 to expand Oxford Houses in Shawnee County which will increase services for those seeking addiction treatment.

In addition, Topeka's City Manager committed to make a proposal outlining a dedicated revenue source for the housing trust fund by December 2021 and Mayor Michelle De La Isla committed to
