TUESDAYS WITH THE WORD

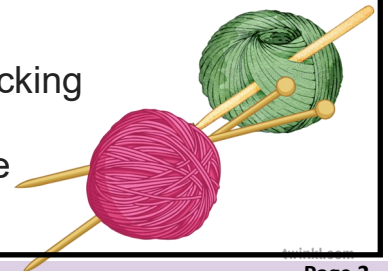

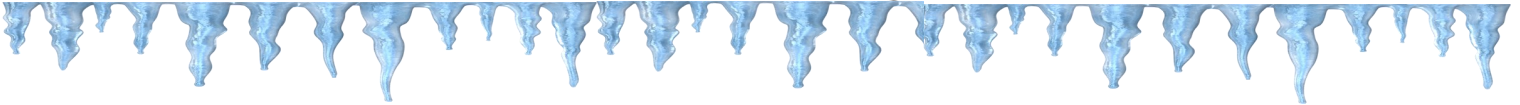
STICKS 'N STRING GROUP (goes back to church!)

GRAB & GO SUMMER FREE MEALS

Trinity has been approved to continue as a site for USD 501 **FREE** meals distribution for children 1-18 years of age while school is out for the summer. We started Wednesday, June 9th. The program continues through August 4.

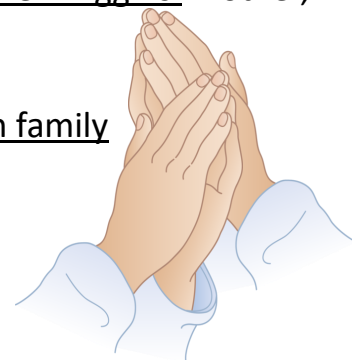

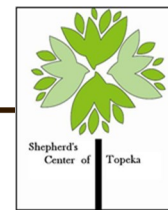

Shepherd's Center of Topeka Smoked Pork Butt BBQ Fundraiser Purchase a Whole Pork Butt or a Dinner

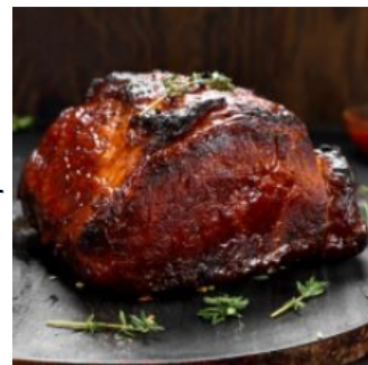


Join us for our first Shepherd's Center BBQ Fundraiser! All proceeds go to SCT to help with operating expenses.
