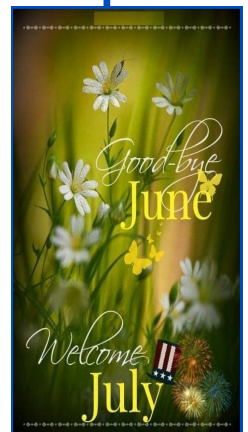

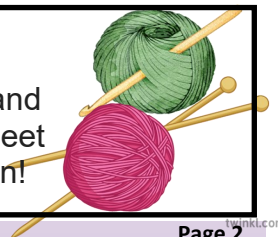

## GRAB & GO SUMMER FREE MEALS

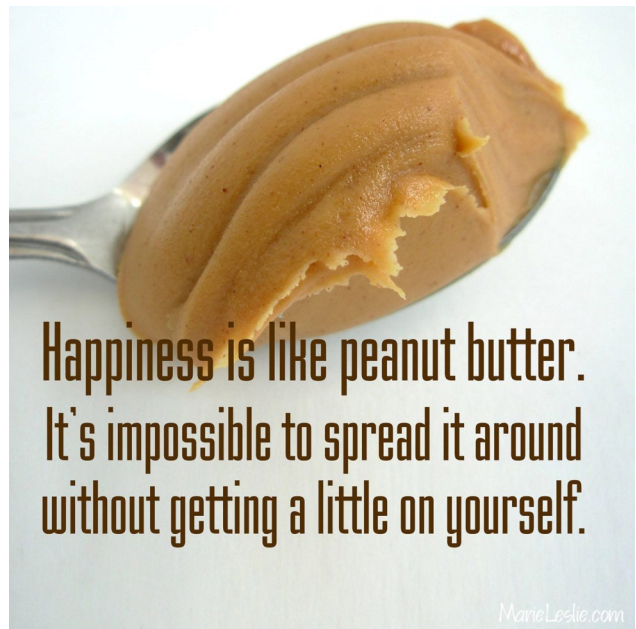
