TUESDAYS WITH THE WORD - NEW LOCATION

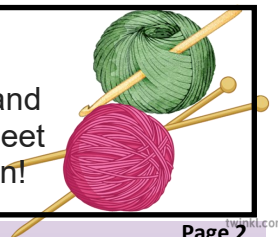

GRAB & GO SUMMER FREE MEALS

Trinity has been approved to continue as a site for USD 501 **FREE** meals distribution for children 1-18 years of age while school is out for the summer. The 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches, milk and juice is provided free through the Summer Food Service Program of USD 501. **ANY CHILD age 1-18** is eligible to receive these meals.
