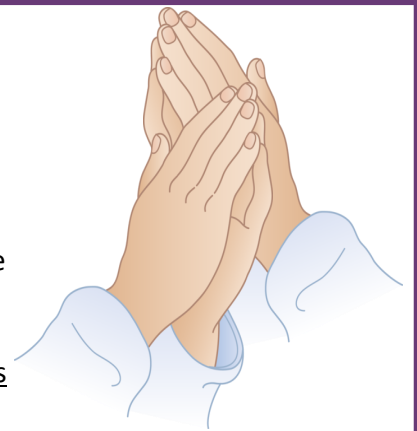

GRAB & GO SUMMER FREE MEALS

Trinity has been approved to continue as a site for USD 501

FREE meals distribution for children 1-18 years of age while school is out for the summer. The 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches, milk and juice is provided free through the Summer Food Service Program of USD 501.

ANY CHILD age 1-18 is eligible to receive these meals. No registration or enrollment in USD 501 is required. If you know of families with children, pass the word. The program continues through August 4.

VOLUNTEERS NEEDED For Grab & Go Summer Meal Distribution

Trinity needs volunteer teams to distribute the free meals to children through the summer. Each Wednesday, the prepared food is delivered to Trinity by USD 501. We need **2-3 volunteers** in the morning to bag the food and then help distribute the meals curbside between 11 a.m. and 12 noon.

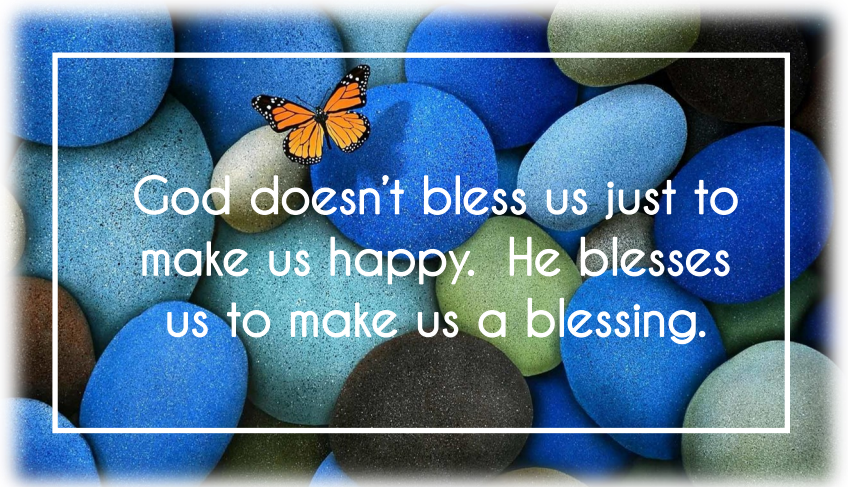
1. The Low Self-Esteem Support Group will meet Thursday at 7:00. Please use the back door.
