

GRAB & GO SUMMER FREE

Trinity has been approved to continue as a site for USD 501

FREE meals distribution for children 1-18
years of age while school is out for the summer. The 7 breakfasts and 7 lunches, milk and juice is provided free through the Summer Food Service Program of USD 501.

ANY CHILD age 1-18 is eligible to receive these meals. No registration or enrollment in USD 501 is required. If you know of families with children, pass the word. The program continues through August 4.
