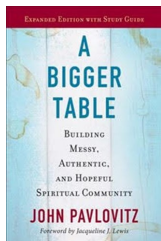
## PAGE TURNERS FRIDAY BOOK STUDY

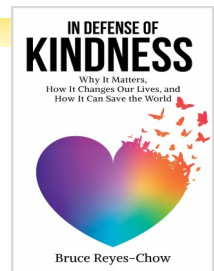

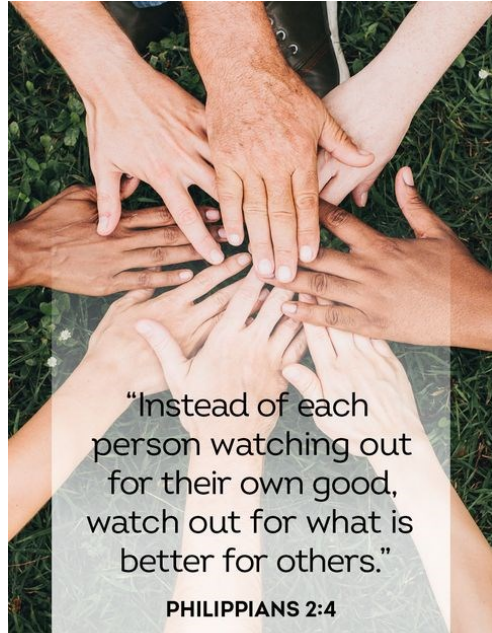
