

# **TUESDAYS WITH THE WORD - NEW LOCATION**





## **Doorstep Update ~ October, 2021**

Doorstep is disappointed to move the Neighbor to Neighbor Walk to virtual status. We were looking forward to seeing the faces of all who have been supporting us through this pandemic as we built back resources to continue to serve the community. The walk is off, but the drive to raise funds for the coming year is as important as ever. We are attempting to celebrate our 55<sup>th</sup> Anniversary by raising funds to replace the 60 year old HVAC system in the building. With COVID is an important step to be able to open up fully to serve the community. So far \$31,000 of the \$129,000 needed as this campaign continues.

Doorstep planning to operate the Christmas Store this year. 260 households of 800+ individuals from the Christmas Bureau will receive a holiday meal and an opportunity to 'shop' for gifts.


