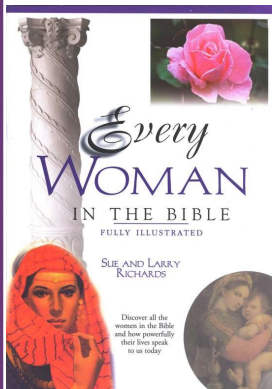


The Stewardship Committee has chosen the theme

It's first come/first served until the food is all distributed.

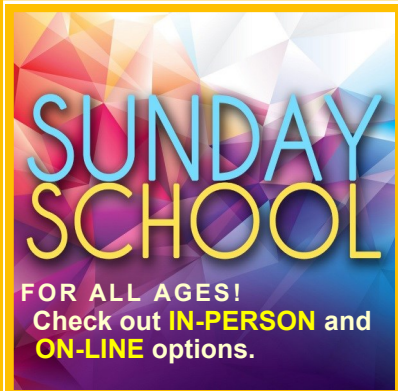
