

The staff will be available to continue to assist as follows.

DURING OFFICE STAFF WORK HOURS - 9:30 A.M. TO 4:30 A.M. (NORMAL WORK DAYS)

- schedule a meeting with a staff person.

- schedule a pick up of mail from your Session mail box.

The church BUILDING is still open for:

- Donated items to be dropped off in the church lobby or other locations in the church.
- Donations in envelopes should be slid under the church office door.
- Meetings in other areas of the church.

DURING NON-STAFF WORK HOURS - weekends, holidays, etc.

- The office is open for those members who must conduct normal church related business.


