

In an effort to reduce exposure to our office staff, the **CHURCH OFFICE CONTINUES TO BE CLOSED** to all Trinity members and visitors who have not called the office and made an appointment in advance of coming to the church through the end of February. We will continue to assess the need and let you know if it changes.

The staff is **STILL** available to continue to assist as follows:

**DURING OFFICE STAFF WORK HOURS** - 9:30 A.M. TO 4:30 A.M. (**NORMAL WORK DAYS**)

Call **BEFORE** coming to the church office to:

- make consultation arrangements with a staff person. (Phone and Zoom meetings are preferred.)

- schedule a pick up of mail from your Session mail box.

The church **BUILDING** is still **open** for:

- Donated items to be dropped off in the church lobby or other locations in the church.
- Donations in envelopes should be slid under the church office door.
- Meetings in other areas of the church.

**DURING NON-STAFF WORK HOURS** - weekends, holidays, etc.

- The office **is open** for those members who must conduct normal church related business.
