





All that is needed is to fill out the **BUY THE CASE** form and select which food items you would like to purchase, or select an undesignated amount, or both. The form and your check or money can be placed

in an envelope and sent to the church or placed in the offering box at the church. The forms and envelopes are in the pews at church, and also at the area by the door where the cases will be placed as we purchase them. The forms will also be included in the Candle and Talking Trinity. We will be placing our order and when it comes in, taking it to the church, and finally to Doorstep. The undesignated amounts will be given to Doorstep for them to use in obtaining additional food.

Trinity has done a wonderful job of supporting Doorstep and providing food for them to distribute to those in need. As the cost of food increases, it becomes hard for families to get the food and nourishment that they need.
