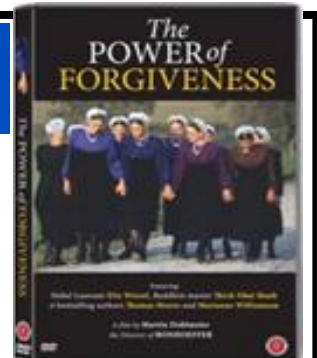

## TRINITY DELEGATION TO VISIT EL SALVADOR IN JUNE!

A Trinity delegation (currently Anton Ahrens and Susan Stickley,) will be traveling to El Salvador the beginning of June. [It's not too late to reserve your spot.](#)

June 11-17, the delegation will visit the capital, San Salvador where we will learn about the joint ventures of the PCUSA and IRCES (the Reformed church of El Salvador), attend Sunday worship services at the Calvinist reformed church in Nuevo Calvario, and visit Los Talpetates and Rio Los Bueyes.



While in Talpetates, we will engage in visits with students of all ages, community leaders, and individuals who are supported by health and educational assistance from Trinity.



We will spend a whole day reviewing the progress of scholarship students pictured here (supported by Trinity).

Each student will provide a certified copy of their latest transcript as well as a letter about how their studies are progressing. Another day in Talpetates will be spent visiting the K-8 school where two of the twelve teachers are supported by Trinity's budget. The school children will be given a "day off" to entertain the Topeka delegation with singing and dancing, fireworks and English practice.

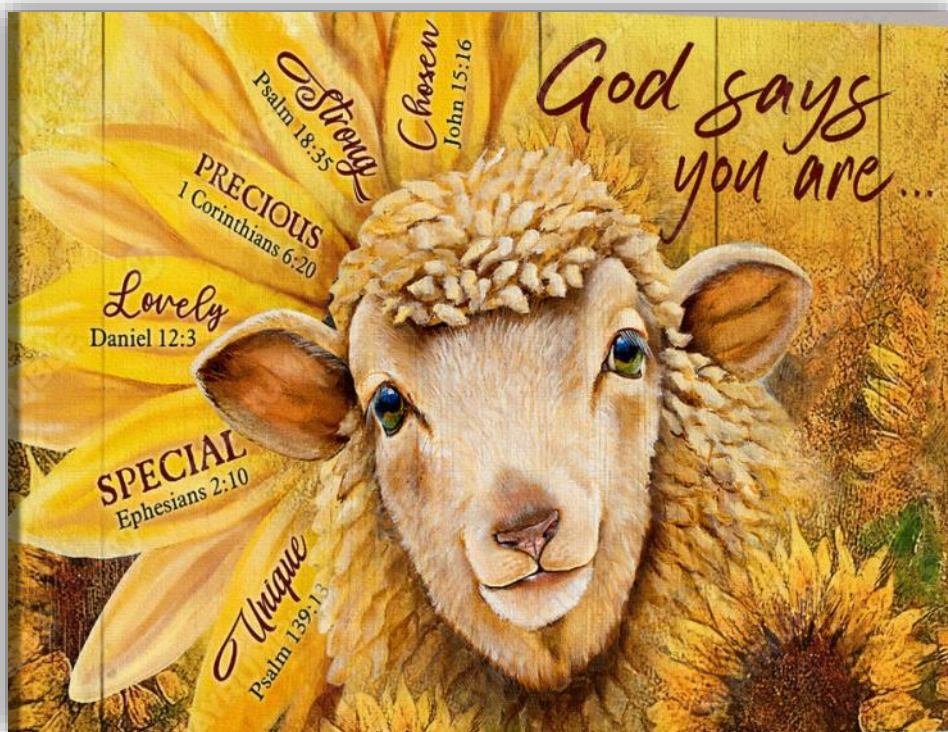
