

LAMENTATIONS 3: 1-9, 19-26

- 3 I am the man who has seen affliction by the rod of the LORD's wrath.
 - ² He has driven me away and made me walk in darkness rather than light;
 - ³ indeed, he has turned his hand against me again and again, all day long.
- ⁴ He has made my skin and my flesh grow old and has broken my bones.
 - ⁵ He has besieged me and surrounded me with bitterness and hardship.
 - ⁶ He has made me dwell in darkness like those long dead.



SCRIPTURE -

- ⁷ He has walled me in so I cannot escape; he has weighed me down with chains.
 - ⁸ Even when I call out or cry for help, he shuts out my prayer.
 - ⁹ He has barred my way with blocks of stone;
- 19 I remember my affliction and my wandering, the bitterness and the gall.
 - ²⁰ I well remember them, and my soul is downcast within me.
 - ²¹ Yet this I call to mind and therefore I have hope:



SCRIPTURE -NIV

- ²² Because of the LORD's great love we are not consumed,
 - for his compassions never fail.
- ²³ They are new every morning;
- great is your faithfulness.

 24 I say to myself, "The LORD is my portion; therefore I will wait for him."
- ²⁵ The LORD is good to those whose hope is in him, to the one who seeks him;
- ²⁶ it is good to wait quietly for the salvation of the LORD.
- ²⁷ It is good for a man to bear the yoke while he is young.

- ²⁸Let him sit alone in silence, for the LORD has laid it on him.
- ²⁹ Let him bury his face in the dust—there may yet be hope.

Amen.











































CLOSING PRAYER
