## hear our prayer.


For our broken hearts. For our tired spirits. For our lives that have been upended, we pray to you [silence]. Lord, in your mercy,

## hear our prayer.


God, please hear the cries of our hearts and be present with us as we continue walking as your people through this trying time. In your son Jesus's name we pray, **Amen.**




