Mission Statement

The goal of the Youth Discipler is to build disciples for Christ with Middle and High School students, equipping them to share their faith with others. The mission of discipleship in relational environments should be a key component of the youth ministry.

Supervision:

The Youth Discipler reports to the lead Pastor for spiritual and ministry guidance and ongoing performance reviews.

Task:

- Disciple the youth into a personal relationship with God in both large group and smaller relational environments
- Grow the youth ministry by creating attractive and compelling environments to which our youth can invite their friends.
- Teach the youth the Gospel and what that requires from them
- Provide opportunities for nurture, growth and service
- Show Jesus' love through modeling
- Challenge the youth to respond to God's call to serve in their communities and the world
- Support and assist the parents in discipling their youth
- Equip the current youth to share the Gospel with their friends

Responsibilities:

- Be an advocate for youth with the congregation
- Stay abreast of new resources and changes in youth ministry and youth culture and adjust our programming as needed to maintain a current and effective program.
- Keep records of youth participation and manage the youth ministry budget along with the Student Discipleship Team.
- Communicate with youth and parents in a timely manner
- Work in concert with the gifts and talents of other staff members and maintain a strong teamwork mentality.
- Attend weekly Staff Meetings as directed.
- Ensure that the Child Protection Policy is observed in all youth ministry settings.
- Submit weekly report to the Student Discipleship Team Moderator and Pastor.

Qualifications and Aptitudes:

- Clear and observable commitment to Jesus Christ
- A relational and pastoral heart
- Strong written and verbal communication skills, conflict management skills and computer skills
- Proven ability to work effectively with youth, parents, diverse individuals and teams of volunteers.

Standard of Performance:

- Weekly fellowship with Middle and High School Youth
- Attend Student Discipleship Team Meetings monthly
- Attend Staff Meetings as directed
- Attend field trips and special events involving youth (i.e. Camps, Community events etc.) as directed
