The candidate will also recruit and support adult volunteers in accomplishing this work.

We are a congregation, located in the historic Five Points neighborhood, with almost 900 members, which includes 100 youth. RPC is looking for a candidate who:

- Has a deep, vibrant faith compatible with our PCUSA theology
- Exhibits strong communication skills and ability to connect with both youth and parents
- Is able to effectively teach youth a greater understanding of scripture and how it relates to their lives
- Understands challenges facing youth and families today impacting their participation in church related activities, especially Sunday School and youth group.

This position will average approximately 30 hours per week and will require flexible hours including weekends, evenings, and overnight trips during the summer. College degree and experience working with youth in a faith setting are preferred.
