Idlewild Presbyterian is a community in which


- Jesus Christ is at the center



THE MINISTRY ROLE

The Director of Youth Ministry works with the Christian Formation Unit and the Youth Ministry Committee to guide youth and their families to know, love, and serve Christ.



ESSENTIAL FUNCTIONS OF THE ROLE

Relational and Programmatic Leadership

- Coordinate and lead weekly programs for middle and high school youth, including Sunday morning church school and Sunday afternoon fellowship.
- Coordinate outreach, mission, and fellowship events for middle and high school youth.
- Establish learning and experiential goals for all ages and create a plan for meeting these goals.
- Demonstrate sensitivity and pastoral discernment in working with diverse youth and their families.

Volunteer Development


- Enlist, train, and support volunteer leaders and teachers.
- Collaborate with church leadership to connect with other ministries of the church.
- Ensure the ministry's compliance with Idlewild's Child Protection policy.

Equipping and Supporting Parents and Families


- Support families in nurturing the faith of their children.
- Communicate regularly with parents concerning opportunities and resources for youth and families.
- Seek out and develop opportunities for youth to participate in all areas of church life.
