Festival of Lessons & Carols

The Festival of Lessons and Carols is a bridge between the liturgical seasons of Advent and Christmas. The service today is an adaptation of the form used on Christmas Eve at King's College Chapel in Cambridge, England. As the service begins, the prayers of the people are sought for those in need at Christmastime. The nine lessons which follow, detail the salvation story of God's people, from the time of creation through the prophets, and conclude with the fulfillment of these prophecies as recorded in the gospels. Each lesson is followed by a carol or anthem.
