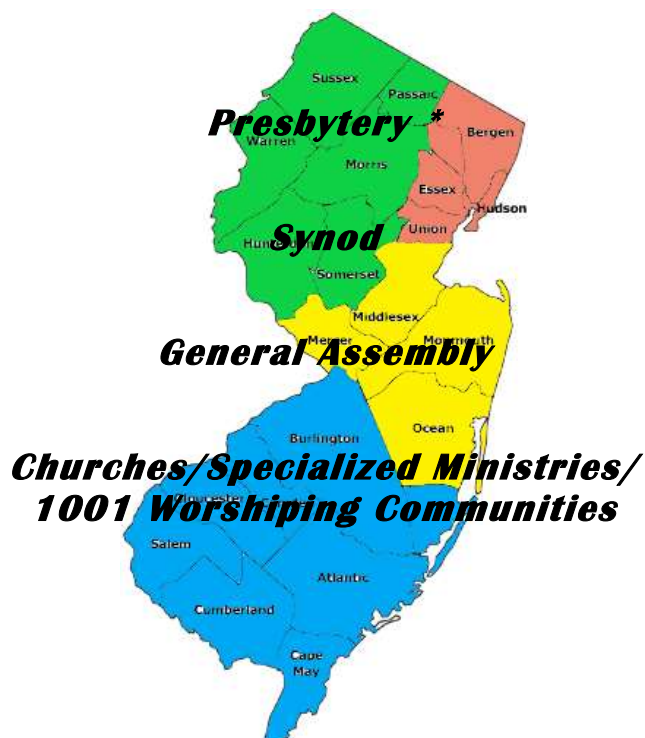

REPORT

We Are Here

The New Jersey Missional Communities Transitions Working Group (NJMCTWG) began its work in January of 2020 with two representatives appointed by each of the seven New Jersey presbyteries along with several members-at-large who provided expertise and support. At our outset we added individuals to our group in an effort to move us towards a broad inclusion of age, LGBTQAI+ identity, race/ethnicity and context, so as to reflect a fuller expression of the diversity found in New Jersey's PC(USA) churches. Together we have sought to follow the leading of the Spirit, discerning how we might recast a vision of shared missional life through the transformation of our presbyteries into spiritual communities that honor the work of administration but center our people and ministries *as living witnesses to the sovereign activity of God in the world so that they become communities of faith, hope, love and witness* (G-3.0301).

We asked over and over: What are we building? What will be different? How will life together as New Jersey Presbyterians be enhanced beyond boundaries and structures? The extraordinary nature inherent to altering presbytery boundaries has borne no shortage of possibilities to examine as we face the realities and unique calling of the 21st century church.

We Are Here

After diligent consideration of statewide resources and structural possibilities, the NJMCTWG formally recommends the vision cast by the NJ Missional Structures Working Group: the dissolution of our seven presbyteries and creation of four presbyteries/missional communities. For the time being, these missional communities will be identified by region: South, Central, Northwest and Northeast. The names of the new communities are to be self-determined when their life together begins. The shaping of these communities has been intentional, with the desire to reflect a balance of diversity in as many forms as possible (congregational size, community type, culture, etc.). Attention has been paid to the issue of equity, striving to ensure there are resources available to allow the strongest breadth of possibility in staffing and shared mission for each presbytery/missional community. While these new communities will retain the unique witness and “flavor” of geographic regions, the hope and expectation has been laid for a new way of working together across the state to serve our congregations, 1001 worshipping communities, validated ministries, schools and educational institutions, camp and retreat center, and other extensions of the work of our state.

We Are Here

See I am doing a new thing! Now it springs up; do you not perceive it? (Isaiah 43:19) We believe that God is doing a new thing in New Jersey. One of the goals of this reconfiguration is greater connection and collaboration with Presbyterians throughout the state. We recognize and honor the anxiety and grief that may be felt as congregations find themselves apart from friends and partners in ministry. It is our hope, however, that those presbyteries that are being asked to send churches to new missional communities rest in the sure and certain knowledge that boundary lines do not have the power to end valued relationships. We will all find ourselves called to this new chapter in the life of New Jersey Presbyterians, turning the page as we explore the continuation of our story together.

RATIONALE

The NJMCTWG affirms the core tenets of the NJ Missional Structures Working Group: The Church’s ministries and methods in the 21st century are changing in ways we know and ways unclear, specifically in this time shaped by the pandemic. We believe that God’s provision for our ministry is taking a new form: fewer separate entities and greater collaboration, bringing about a new, statewide missional community, gathered into four entities.

While the presbyteries of our state have differed in both success and struggle, all have provided faithful witness to our Lord, Jesus Christ. All presbyteries have been united in needing to consider issues of declining membership and subsequent declining resources. We have all tried

to do more with less. Most, if not all, have longed for change in our presbyteries. Not change for change's sake - but change to the structure and function of presbytery itself. We believe that this change should be a move away from a model that centers on legal and administrative organization towards a missional community so that our congregations and specialized ministries can be empowered to be *the church engaged in the mission of God in its particular context.* (G-1.01).

The phrase "*missional community*" speaks to the importance of the church of Jesus Christ. *Congregations of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.), while possessing all the gifts necessary To be the church, are nonetheless not sufficient in themselves to be the church. Rather, they are called to share with others both within and beyond the congregation the task of bearing witness to the Lordship of Jesus Christ in the world. This call to bear witness is the work of all believers. The particular responsibility of the councils of the church is to nurture, guide, and govern those who witness as part of the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) to the end that such witness strengthens the whole church and gives glory to God.*" (G-3.0101)

We believe the administrative work necessary to conduct the business of our presbyteries is vital, but that it should not be defining. In order to thrive, our presbyteries need to be grounded in relationships that center on trust. Building relational trust within the missional community will lead to an outpouring of vision and effectiveness within the shared life together. By leaning into community, we believe interactions will become connectional rather than transactional.

It is our belief that a missional community structure honors the work of administration, but aspires to a missional identity. We affirm these aspirations found in the invitational document.

- ❖ When the presbytery community gathers, there is a transformational shift: Joy and trust are present; we learn from and inspire one another.
- ❖ We have space and flexibly to follow where God is pushing/leading us.
- ❖ We are relevant to the public, boldly proclaiming and demonstrating life in Christ, which is inspiring people to seek and follow Christ.
- ❖ Through the reconciling work of the Holy Spirit our Gospel communities have broken down the barriers that were keeping us apart (fear, money, distrust) and have reignited our common life as a connectional denomination.
- ❖ We have stepped fully into modern technology, maximizing communication throughout our presbyteries and out into the world around us.
- ❖ Each presbytery provides the "new wineskin" container for a wide variety of ministries (urban, rural, suburban, racial-ethnic, home church, New Worshipping Communities, chaplaincy, etc.). Each leader and ministry is cherished and supported, creating a space of safety, respect, and honor; no part of the body is marginalized. (1 Cor. 12:21-22)

- ❖ Leaders and Gospel communities share responsibilities and have shifted from regulatory oversight to mutual accountability.
- ❖ We now work with better efficiency and broadened resources.
- ❖ We make sometimes-painful decisions based on our effectiveness for the Gospel, which has led us to leave behind some ministries and ways of doing things, retaining our best, and inventing and embracing new ways.
- ❖ We are entrepreneurial – change is constant, so we adapt, trusting and relying on our solid-rock foundation of Christ and none other. (Mt. 7:24-27)
- ❖ Our presbyteries are healthy, functioning with joy, and are known by the public as inspiring, relevant, and engaged faith communities of New Jersey.
- ❖ Our Gospel communities are self-sustaining, and contributing their per capita as a sign of their commitment to the connectedness of our denomination.
- ❖ We provide pastoral support and cutting-edge training for all lay and clergy leaders.
- ❖ A wave of collaboration between Gospel communities has deepened our joy and witnessed to the world God’s reconciliation, wholeness, and unity amidst diversity.
- ❖ We as individuals and gospel communities share a sacred resource: our stories – being vulnerable to reveal who we are, what we are up to, our needs and hopes, and how the community can support us as we “run with perseverance the race marked out for us” (Heb. 12:1).
- ❖ To the glory of the Triune God, we are living into “God’s preferred future” secure in God’s faithfulness.

We believe these aspirations are best realized with the reorganization of our seven current presbyteries, resulting in the creation of four new presbyteries/missional communities. The extraordinary nature inherent to altering presbytery boundaries has borne no shortage of possibilities for our group to examine. Different models have been duly considered, including but not limited to one statewide presbytery. After extensive examination of data from each presbytery including: membership and resources including both people and finances, consideration of geographic size, balance of the number of overall membership and number of churches, traffic and other transportation challenges, diversity and inclusion, access and maximization of shared resources, sensitivity to regional affinities, the unique organizational cultures of our existing bodies and the importance of county lines for resources and services, we have concluded that a one, two or three presbytery model is simply too large to meet our aspirational goals.

While diversity in all forms defines the technical details at the core of the four presbytery/missional community model, the whole of this model is wrapped in the missional community to which Christ calls us. *For as in one body we have many members, and not all members have the same function, so we, who are many, are one body in Christ, and individually we are members one of another.* (Romans 12:5) In particular, we hold that four presbyteries/missional communities will best work to ensure that the voices of smaller and/or marginalized communities are supported and heard.

The councils of the church shall give full expression to the rich diversity of the church's membership and shall provide for full participation and access to representation in decision-making and employment practices. In fulfilling this commitment, councils shall give due consideration to both the gifts and requirements for ministry and the right of people in congregations and councils to elect their officers. (G-3.0103)

As a representational working group, we understand in full the change this brings across the state and that some regions are impacted by the change more than others. We believe that changed boundaries do not have the power to change long-standing relationships. Changed boundaries do have the power to bring the possibility for our presbyteries to flourish, with greater membership and greater resources.

After a long journey, we are here.

Here, in recognition that current and future sustainability will require change.

Here, with a longing to empower our churches, specialized ministries, 1001 worshipping communities and more as living witnesses to the sovereign activity of God in the world so that they become communities of faith, hope, love and witness.

Here, at this Kairos moment.

Recommendation to the Synod of the Northeast

September 2020

RECOMMENDATION:

The New Jersey Missional Communities Transitions Working Group was constituted in accordance with the final phase of the New Jersey Missional Structures initiative, approved by the Synod of the Northeast, when it adopted the “Monmouth Overture” to:

1. Work with those [NJ] presbyteries to ascertain their needs and goals,
2. Examine the present boundaries and structures of those presbyteries,
3. Consider the possibility of redrawing presbytery boundaries, and
4. Make recommendations to the Synod.

This motion from the NJMC Transitions Working Group addresses the specifics of the geographic regions, the congregations and ministers, and the financial resources and real property of the seven NJ presbyteries, Elizabeth, Monmouth, New Brunswick, Newark, Newton, Palisades, and West Jersey. The goal of the Working Group is to send an overture to the General Assembly to request their approval after it is approved by the Synod of the Northeast. This motion proposes the reorganization of the seven NJ presbyteries into four presbyteries.

Synod’s responsibility for making these decisions comes from the Presbyterian Church (U.S.A.) Constitution, Part II, *Book of Order* G-3.0403 and G-3.0403c: *The synod has responsibility for supporting the work of the presbyteries within its bounds and as such is charged with:*

c. organizing new presbyteries, dividing, uniting, or otherwise combining presbyteries or portions of presbyteries previously existing, and, with the concurrence of existing presbyteries, creating non-geographic presbyteries, subject to the approval of the General Assembly,

The following motion will be presented and discussed in parts but voted on as one unified motion in each of the seven presbyteries.

All parts of this motion become effective on the date of approval by the GA. Endorsement of this motion by each of the seven NJ presbyteries will also serve as their individual action requesting changes to the bounds of their presbytery and/or their dissolution. The component parts are listed from North to South in the State of New Jersey.

1. NAMES AND BOUNDARIES: (please note: these names are temporary regional identifiers, not approved names for the new presbyteries)

- **“Northwest” Presbytery** - The geographic region of the current Newton Presbytery will be combined with the congregations of Pompton Valley in Morris County, and West Milford, Ringwood, Bloomingdale, Wanaque and Pompton Lakes in Passaic County of the current Palisades Presbytery, all of the congregations in the geographic region of Hunterdon and Somerset Counties of the current Elizabeth Presbytery, and all of the congregations in the geographic region of Hunterdon and Somerset Counties, except for the unincorporated community of Kingston, of the current Presbytery of New Brunswick to form a new “Northwest” Presbytery. The resultant bounds of the new “Northwest” Presbytery will consist of all the churches and teaching elders located in Hunterdon, Morris, Sussex, Warren and Somerset Counties in New Jersey, and the towns of West Milford, Ringwood, Bloomingdale, Wanaque and Pompton Lakes in Passaic County, New Jersey. The congregations and their properties in the current presbyteries will be combined to the new presbytery. *[see attachment 1]*
- **“Northeast” Presbytery** - The geographic region of the current Newark Presbytery will be combined with the geographic region of the current Palisades Presbytery, except for the congregations of Pompton Valley in Morris County, and Ringwood, West Milford, Bloomingdale, Wanaque and Pompton Lakes in Passaic County, and the geographic region of Union County of the current Elizabeth Presbytery to form a new “Northeast” Presbytery. The resultant bounds of the “Northeast” Presbytery will consist of all the churches and teaching elders located in Bergen, Essex, Hudson and Union Counties in New Jersey and all of Passaic County in New Jersey except for the towns of Ringwood and West Milford, Bloomingdale, Wanaque and Pompton Lakes. The congregations and their properties in the current presbyteries will be combined to the new presbytery. *[see attachment 2]*
- **“Central” Presbytery** - The geographic region of the current New Brunswick Presbytery in Mercer and Middlesex Counties will be combined with the geographic region of Elizabeth Presbytery in Middlesex County, and the current geographic region of Monmouth Presbytery in the portion of Ocean County from Lacey Township northward to form a new “Central” Presbytery. The resultant bounds of the “Central” Presbytery will consist of all the churches and teaching elders located in Mercer, Middlesex, and Monmouth Counties in New Jersey, and the northern portion of Ocean County in New Jersey, from Lacey Township northward. The congregations and their properties in the current presbyteries will be combined to the new presbytery. *[see attachment 3]*
- **“Southern” Presbytery** - The geographic region of the current West Jersey Presbytery will be combined with the portion of the geographic region of Ocean County south of Lacey Township to form a new “Southern” Presbytery. The resultant bounds of the “Southern” Presbytery will consist of all the churches and teaching elders located in Atlantic, Burlington, Camden, Cape May, Cumberland, Gloucester, and Salem Counties in New Jersey, and the southern portion of Ocean County south of Lacey Township, New Jersey. The congregations and their properties in the current presbyteries will be combined to the new presbytery. *[see attachment 4]*

2. MEMBERS OF THE PRESBYTERY

- The Ministers of Word and Sacrament within the participating communities in the existing presbyteries will become members of the new combined presbytery.
- Ministers who live in the geographic regions being combined into the new presbytery who are not connected to a congregation or validated ministry of the newly combined presbytery, e.g. Members at Large or Honorably Retired members, may request that their membership move to the presbytery of their choice in NJ.
- Commissioned Ruling Elders will retain their certification in the new presbytery and their commission will be transferred to the new presbytery in which their congregation resides.

3. **FINANCIAL RESOURCES AND REAL PROPERTY**

The transfer of financial resources and real property from the current presbyteries to the new presbyteries will be performed as noted below for each of the new presbyteries.

- “Northwest” Presbytery
 1. Newton Presbytery – all assets and liabilities
 2. Palisades Presbytery – a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Northwest” presbytery compared to the total number of members of congregations in Palisades Presbytery as of December 31, 2019. Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Northwest” Presbytery.
 3. Elizabeth Presbytery - a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Northwest” presbytery compared to the total number of members of congregations in Elizabeth Presbytery as of December 31, 2019. Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Northwest” Presbytery.
 4. New Brunswick Presbytery - a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Northwest” presbytery compared to the total number of members of congregations in New Brunswick Presbytery as of December 31, 2019. Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Northwest” Presbytery.
- “Northeast” Presbytery
 1. Newark Presbytery – all assets and liabilities
 2. Palisades Presbytery – a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being

dismissed to the new “Northeast” presbytery compared to the total number of members in Palisades Presbytery as of December 31, 2019.

Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Northeast” Presbytery.

3. Elizabeth Presbytery - a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Northeast” presbytery compared to the total number of members in Elizabeth Presbytery as of December 31, 2019.

Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Northeast” Presbytery.

In addition, the ownership of the Elizabethport Presbyterian Center will be transferred to the new “Northeast” Presbytery

- “Central” Presbytery

1. New Brunswick Presbytery – a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Central” presbytery compared to the total number of members in New Brunswick Presbytery as of December 31, 2019.

Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Central” Presbytery.

In addition, the title for the property at 21 Clinton St, Trenton will be transferred to the new “Central” Presbytery.

2. Monmouth Presbytery – a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Central” presbytery compared to the total number of members in Monmouth Presbytery as of December 31, 2019.

Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Central” Presbytery.

3. Elizabeth Presbytery - a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Central” presbytery compared to the total number of members in Elizabeth Presbytery as of December 31, 2019.

Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Central” Presbytery.

- “Southern” Presbytery

1. West Jersey Presbytery – All assets and liabilities.

2. Monmouth Presbytery – a portion of all assets reported at the most recent month-end financial report apportioned by the number of members of congregations being dismissed to the new “Southern” presbytery compared to the total number of members in Monmouth Presbytery as of December 31, 2019.

Also, any accounts receivable for church loans or PILP commitments of the congregations being dismissed to the new “Southern” Presbytery.

4. ***STARTING OUR NEW LIVES TOGETHER***

All relevant participating presbyteries shall come to a mutual agreement on the following items (beginning with synod approval of this proposal and concluding within 1 year after the approval of the GA Commission):

- Proposal of bylaws
- Proposal for merged Governance and Name
- Proposal for Leadership Board Representation
- Proposal for composition and duties of Commission on Ministry
- Proposal for composition and duties of Commission on Preparation for Ministry
- Proposal for Staff Transition
- Proposal for Nomination of Officers
- Proposal for the Setting of Meetings
- Disposition of the Permanent Judicial Commission and roster of former PJC members
- Disposition and composition of Committees on Nominations and Representation
- Disposition of board-restricted funds
- Disposition of donor-restricted funds
- Completion of a full financial audit of the former presbytery
- Proposal and approval of a Unified budget
- A plan for parity between Teaching Elders and Ruling Elders
- Initiate full financial audit for all current presbyteries

5. ***SEAMLESS TRANSITION***

We request that the Synod of the Northeast constitute an Administrative Commission for New Jersey Missional Communities (NJMCAC), which would be charged with performing any essential activities on behalf of the former and new presbyteries prior to, during, or after the transition is approved by the General Assembly.
