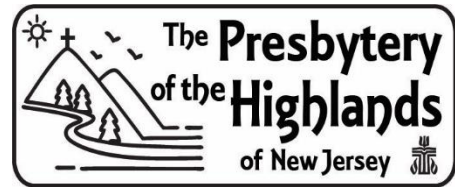


Nominating Team

Purpose:

With commitment to representing the presbytery's diversity in the commissions, teams and offices of the presbytery, and in fulfillment of the presbytery's mission, the Nominating Team identifies and nominates persons to fill all vacancies in elected positions (positions identified as such in the team descriptions of the Manual of Administrative Operations).



Responsibilities:

1. Works creatively to identify those whose gifts and passion could be invited in service to presbytery commissions and teams.
2. Accepts responsibility for contacting potential nominees, exploring the potential for their service and reporting responses back to the Nominating Team chair.
3. Nominates persons to fill all vacancies in elected positions (positions identified as such in the team descriptions of the Manual of Administrative Operations).
4. Consults, at least annually, with the Committee on Representation

Membership

The Nominating Team ordinarily consists of 6 people, identified by the Administration and Coordinating team. The team shall include both teaching and ruling elders, as well as non-ordained members of congregations of the presbytery, both male and female, a range of age groups, reflecting the diversity of the presbytery. A quorum will be 50%. Members of the team are elected by the presbytery to serve a three-year term, with option to renew for an additional term.
