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Youth Director

Position Description

The Youth Director is responsible for providing hands-on leadership and innovation for PCMP's Youth Ministry programs. The core programs include annual mission trip and outreach into the community.

Plan and Lead Youth Activities

- Develop, coordinate, and lead all church youth activities
- Hold regular youth group meetings
- Organize and chaperone youth retreats or mission trips
- Discover new and fun recreational activities that will continue to engage our youth in meaningful Christian discipleship
- Work 10 hours per week, including Sundays, at \$15 per hour

Job Description

- Help youth to discover their God-given gifts, talents, and abilities through faith-based learning programs
- Develop and maintain programs for middle through senior high school-aged children
- Collaborate with pastors and staff to coordinate liturgical activities i.e., young adult mission programs, etc.
- Help recruit and foster relationships with the elementary school children for Club 345 leaders and volunteers
- Engage with parents/families to generate support and participation in ministry programs

Report to Church

An additional key area of responsibility relates to your role as an employee within the church. The Youth Director will have obligations to the organization similar to other church employees. You will directly report to the pastor. Youth activities align with objectives and strategies of the church's mission and philosophy. You will also coordinate with the Christian Education Coordinator and the Christian Education Elder which would include attending Christian Education Ministry meetings once a month.

Background Requirements

The requirements to become a Youth Director vary. You must believe in and support the beliefs of the Presbyterian Church, USA. Biblical knowledge and spiritual discipline are required as well. Leadership skills, judgment, decision-making, and communication skills are also important in the Youth Director role. Previous experience working with children and youth is preferred.
