



Job Title: Director of Music Ministry

Responsibilities:

- 1) Plan, rehearse and lead various styles of worship music during the liturgical calendar yr.
- 2) Work collegially with the Pastor, the Director of Youth Choir, additional worship musicians, the office administrator, and the church Elder for Worship.
- 3) Organize and maintain the church music library.
- 4) Supervise the use and maintenance of church musical instruments.

Skills Required:

- 1) Piano and vocal proficiency a must.
- 2) Ability to read music and arrange musical selections.
- 3) Ability to select music appropriate to (1) the seasons of the liturgical cycle (2) diverse styles and streams of sacred music, (3) the skill levels of all music participants.
- 4) Willingness to work closely and respectfully with others.

Time Commitment:

- 3 hours, 3-4 Sundays per month plus additional week for months with 5 Sundays.
- Additional 3-5 hours of time per month (music selection and practice, scheduling guest musicians, weekly work on worship liturgy, and quarterly planning meetings.)
- Christmas and Easter season services.
