RESPONSIBILITIES:

- 2. Provide appropriate music for regularly scheduled services.
- 3. Provide accompaniment for senior choir, children's choirs, and/or guest soloist rehearsals and worship services.
- 4. Provide appropriate music for special services including, but not limited to, the following:
 - -Maundy Thursday worship
 - -Good Friday worship
 - -Thanksgiving eve worship
 - -Christmas eve worship services

(Appropriate music includes, but is not limited to, a prelude, postlude, accompaniment to hymns, accompaniment to choirs.)

- 8. Attend every other month staff meeting to facilitate planning and any other staff meetings as scheduled

Relationships: Relates to the Pastor, the Worship Council, Music/Senior Choir Director, other choir directors, and the Director of Family Ministries in the performance of responsibilities

Evaluations: Performance reviews will be conducted at least annually by the Pastor and the Session Personnel Council. The Session Personnel Council will annually review the adequacy of the compensation.
