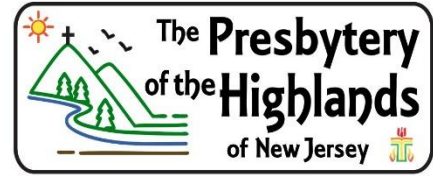


Interim Pastor Position Description First Oxford and Delaware Presbyterian Churches



The part time Interim/Transitional pastor will fulfill the following specific responsibilities:

- Plan, lead and deliver a sermon during one worship service each week and for special services. Service locations alternate between the two churches. Provide sacraments as needed or required.
- Officiate at weddings and funerals.
- Support the church's programs: Mission, Worship, and Music
- Visit hospitalized members and shut-ins and administer the Sacrament of Communion as requested.
- Serve as Moderator of the Session.
- Assist boards and committees of the church in their ministry as scheduled.
- Attend Presbytery meetings and keep Committee on Ministry (COM) informed on the health of the congregation.
- Train newly elected officers and work with boards and committees to set yearly goals.
- Lead a Joint Bible Study or Workshops for the faith development of members and new members if requested.
- Be available to congregation members.
- Lead the Congregation through a Discernment Study, following the process approved by the Missional Ministry Team, which will lead to election of the Pastor Nominating Committee and the Mission Information Form (MIF).

Terms of Call

- Position will be for nineteen hours per week on a part time basis.
