Dear PPC,

As kids and teachers head back-to-school this month, we are excited to be launching PPC's ministries for fall. This newsletter is packed with ways to worship, connect, learn, and serve with us.



Many of you provided feedback about worship times for fall through a survey earlier this summer. We discovered an overall preference in the congregation for our later service to take place at 10:30am and session voted unanimously to support this request. We are planning for two services—one at 8:30am and the second at 10:30am, with a joint Christian education and choir time in between. We recognize that this schedule will be different for us all and that it will provide some new opportunities as well as challenges. Session agreed to see how it goes and reassess at our November meeting, adapting as needed.

One key question posed by a church member at our July Pastors' Chat was how we can engage and support families with young children in the church, especially amid the challenges of COVID. This question was a spark, igniting the creativity of the Holy Spirit in my own mind and heart and in our Worship Committee. At our August Worship Committee meeting, we began planning a special approach to our 8:30am service to intentionally include our youngest worshippers.

This 8:30am service will be highly interactive and accessible for worshippers of all ages and abilities. We encourage the whole congregation to experience it at some point this fall. At its best, Christian worship is an intergenerational experience, with people of all ages connecting with God and one another, so we hope to include young children and their families as well as those who can be the spiritual aunts, uncles, and grandparents to these families in the church.

At our August 3 session meeting, we discussed a draft of the PPC Worship Values as expressed by our Worship Values Team earlier this summer. We are excited to share these with all of you and believe they will resonate in very

meaningful ways with the congregation, expressing PPC's approach to worship as part of our larger Presbyterian tradition and the church universal. We're currently polishing this document, with input from session and the Worship Committee, and hope to approve these core worship values at our September 7 meeting to share with the congregation. Watch for a fall sermon series exploring these values, starting September 12.

At our meeting we also received a COVID update from Kerry Katlic and agreed that, for the time being, we will return to masking in the church building. With this precaution, and care regarding sanitizing surfaces and careful serving of food, session authorized a full return to two worship services and Sunday morning Christian Education, starting September 12.

In preparation for World Communion Sunday on October 3, Session authorized Rev. Dr. Marlowe Washington, a United Methodist pastor and Senior Diversity Officer at St. John Fisher, to preach and lead a conversation with our youth. We're excited to welcome Rev. Dr. Washington to lead us in worship.

Session also approved inviting the congregation to submit suggestions for naming the 5 trails on the hill, began discussing a possible Scripture to be added to the empty panel of our main sign, and authorized Communion for our September 18 youth retreat.

Our next meeting is Tuesday, September 7, 7pm.

### All About Confirmation 2021-2022

We're starting a new confirmation class for youth in 7th-12th grade! We invite all our youth who haven't yet participated in confirmation to consider joining the class. This is an opportunity for you to go deeper in your faith and discover more about how God is working in your life and calling you to be a disciple.

At PPC we believe that the decision about whether or not a youth participates in confirmation is between the youth and his or her parents while the ultimate decision at the end of confirmation about whether the youth will profess his or her faith and join the church as a full member is between each youth and God.

This year confirmation classes will take place on Sunday mornings from 9:30-10:15am, approximately two times per month, for a total of 12 classes.
