- Perinton Presbyterian is a church that welcomes children in worship. Young worshippers are full of wiggles, whispers, cries, yawns, and questions. Young worshippers often want to move, sing, and pray with everyone else. Their parents want a place where they will really feel welcome. **At PPC we say, you and your children are fully, completely welcome here.**

- **Worship Bags** are available in the narthex (entry area)—

You are invited to personalize one for each of your children, pick it up each Sunday as you arrive, then return it to the rack after worship, so that we have it ready for you next week. The sermon is a great time for children to worship by exploring some of the activities in their bags such as “Worship Art.”

- If you need to get up and move around, you are welcome to do so. If you would like to step out for a moment, we have a **Giggle Room** available at the back of the sanctuary.
- **Children’s bulletins** for ages 3 and older are available and will be passed out as you enter the sanctuary.
- **Prayer request cards** can be found in the pews and placed in an offering plate.
- **Communion** is celebrated the first Sunday of the month. We will be using small cups of pre-packaged bread and juice. A gluten-free option is available.
- Worship services are **livestreamed** on Facebook
- Our church has an **Assistive Listening System** in the sanctuary. Please ask an usher for a portable receiver and earbuds or you may bring your own earbuds.
