I have worked with a ministry coach for the last 12 years. It has been a great way for me to work with others, to look outside myself and to define my personal mission in doing ministry work.

The other thing it has done, is to help me remain faithful to my calling. I am able to pray about the work I am doing, to talk about it with others and to get feedback on how I am doing.

Faithfulness as a congregation looks a little different. To be faithful as a congregation, we need to hear from the people within our community, we need to hear from God and we need to hear from an outsider who is affected directly or indirectly.

As my coach has said, "faithfulness comes from the creative tension that occurs in the interplay of the three distinct voices: God's voice, our own voice and the voice of the outsider. Faithful decisions, answers, and outcomes are most likely to be generative when each of the three voices arrive at the conversation with the courage to speak honestly and frankly and the humility to realize their voice is not the only voice that matters."

Throughout the summer will be listening to these three voices as we define with it means to be faithful as Prince of Peace Lutheran Church in Kensington, CT. We will talk with one another, pray together, read scripture together and learn about faithfulness in the midst of our community and calling as the people of God.

This summer I will be starting a series called Faithfulness.

This series will focus on the faithfulness from some of our Biblical Heroes. It will also explore some who are not so faithful and Gods response to those people.

We will also discover how we as a congregation and be faithful with the gifts that God has blessed us with. I am excited to share this with you and to explore these important topics for our church.
