Qualifications and Uses

Purpose:

The Second Church Fund Scholarship program exists in order to support members of Second Presbyterian Church in their pursuit of higher education by awarding annual college scholarships.

Scholarship Type:

The SCF Scholarship(s) given are grants with no requirements for repayment.

Student Criteria:

- The student must be a graduating senior of an accredited high school and be registered or accepted for admission to an approved college or university, junior college, or technical college with a two-year minimum program.
- The student must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 (4.0 scale)
- The student and/or parent(s)/legal guardian must be a member of Second Presbyterian Church for at least one year prior to the application deadline OR the student must demonstrate service and commitment to Second Presbyterian Church.

Alternative Student Criteria:

- The student must have an alternative/equivalent to high school graduation and be registered or accepted for admission to an approved college or university, junior college, or technical college with a two-year minimum program.
- The student must be no older than 20 years of age on the first day of June of the year in which the application is made.
- The student and/or parent(s)/legal guardian must be a member of Second Presbyterian Church for at least one year prior to the application deadline OR the student must demonstrate service and commitment to Second Presbyterian Church.

Scholarship Uses:

The SCF Scholarship money must be used for tuition and/or room and board.

Applications:

Information and applications are available in the church office. Applications must be returned in their entirety as specified by the application to the church office by **JUNE 1**

Scholarship(s) Awarded:

The SCF Scholarship(s) given will be in the amount of \$1,000 per student. The number of scholarships available will be determined based on the return of investments from the previous year.

Payment:

Any SCF Scholarship(s) granted will be paid directly to the school's financial office
