The Moderator welcomed all visitors including the members of the Massanutten Church Pastor Nominating Committee.

PURPOSE OF THE MEETING

Book of Order G-2.0504 c. A presbytery may determine that its mission strategy permits a minister of the Word and Sacrament currently called as an Associate Pastor to be eligible to serve as the next installed pastor or co-pastor, or a minister of the Word and Sacrament employed in a temporary pastoral relationship to be eligible to serve as the next installed pastor, co-pastor, or associate pastor. Presbyteries that permit this eligibility shall establish such relationships only by a three-fourths vote of the members of presbytery present and voting.

The purpose of today's meeting is to receive and vote on the call extended to Teaching Elder Ann Pettit to become co-pastor of Massanutten Presbyterian Church upon the dissolution of her current call as associate pastor.

COMMITTEE ON PASTORAL TRANSITION

Teaching Elder Amy Fetterman, Vice-Chair, presented the following recommendation from the Committee on Pastoral Transition:

That the Presbytery of Shenandoah approve the call of the Massanutten Presbyterian Church to the Rev. Ann Pettit as co-pastor effective September 1, 2021.

Teaching Elder Jonthan Bunker was called on as the chair of Examinations Committee to speak to the examination process which he shared in detail.

Ruling Elder Beth Smith from the Massanutten Pastor Nominating Committee was called upon to share the process of the PNC.

Several questions and comments arose from the Body.

The recommendation was approved 52-0. (There were 55 voting members present; 42 votes were required for the ³/₄ approval.)

The meeting adjourned at 10:38 a.m. with the Moderator leading in prayer. The Presbytery will meet in stated session on Saturday, August 28, 2021, at 9:30 a.m. via Zoom.
