MUST Food for Families


LCR's MUST Food for Families outreach ministry will continue. When this program was initiated last June, it was anticipated it might run through the summer to help families whose children were not

Christmas Eve Parking Lot Worship


We celebrated 3 services in the parking lot on Christmas Eve, each one in
