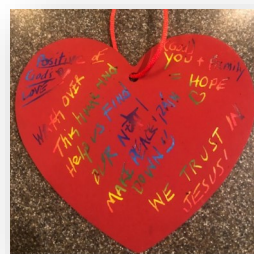

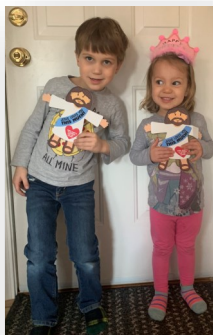
Children

Hope to see your family at Parking Lot Service.



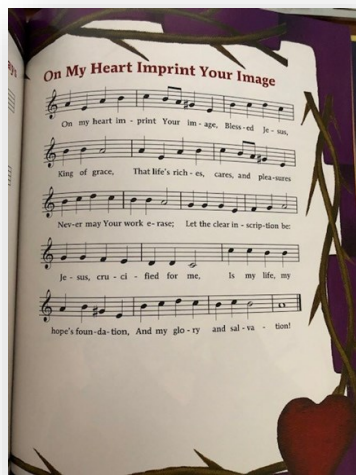
Lydia and Elijah with their Valentine's Day crafts. Lydia said she was going to give hers as a present to God because it looks like him.

Barbara and I decided to put our \$20 toward a GoFundMe donation for our cousin Danny in Oklahoma. He finally was able to come home Friday after being hospitalized originally on August 29 with COVID-19 and then dealing with all that the virus did to his heart, lungs, hands and feet, etc. He now has months of physical therapy ahead of him, including a couple of home physical therapy sessions a week that cost \$150 each with insurance coverage uncertain at this time. He certainly has lots of need for healing and hope ahead of him.
