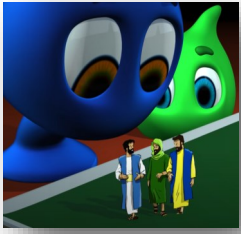

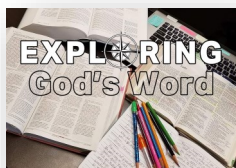

Men's Breakfast Wednesdays at 8:00 am via Zoom

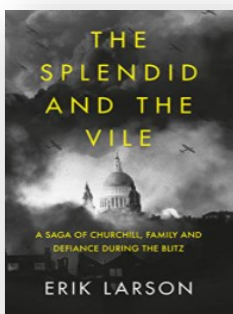
All men are invited to join the Men's Breakfast. During April we will be discussing ELCA—"The Future Church." The study covers the following focal points:
