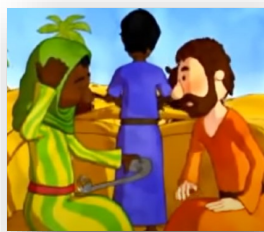

Through May 23 from 9:30-10:15 am**

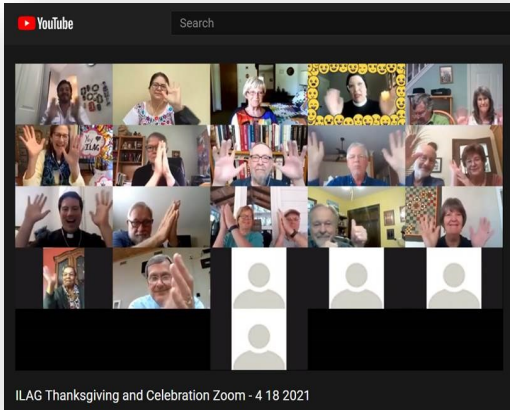

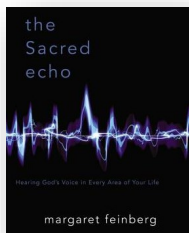
MUST Wednesday Lunch
