### In Person Worship Starting this Sunday, May 9 at 8:30 am

LCR Community,

I am so excited to be returning to in person worship in the Sanctuary at the 8:30 am service. It's a great option for worship at LCR as we continue to live in the midst of this Pandemic. Remember, we will continue to gather for worship at 11:00 am in the Parking Lot. Those watching online can come to the Gathering Room doors from 12 pm–1pm to receive communion from Pastor Dave.

In the 8:30 am Sanctuary worship service we will practice mask wearing, physical distancing, and hand hygiene. Those practices are going to enable us to care for the health of our vulnerable neighbors in worship. Then together we will get to sing with our masks on. You'll get to hear God's Word read and preached from the pews. And you'll get to come forward to receive Holy Communion. It's going to be beautiful, so make sure you register by Friday because space is limited. Register <a href="here">here</a>.

The 8:30 am service will also be available via Radio and YouTube. It will be broadcast live on 95.1 FM for those who would prefer to sit in the parking lot or for those who have not registered for the service. The service will also be live streamed through our <a href="YouTube channel">YouTube channel</a>). If you are not feeling well or have been advised to stay away from public gatherings like worship, please stay home and participate through our YouTube channel.

Here's how we will receive communion at the 8:30 am sanctuary worship service.

- The ushers will direct you to come forward in household pods.
- When you get to the last spot before the pastor, use the hand sanitizer station. Once your hands are clean you have the responsibility to make sure that the person in front of you is beginning to head back before you come forward.
- You will then come forward to receive the host, and as is our practice in the parking lot, please fully extend your arms to receive the sacrament.
- Then move to the Assisting Minister station to receive the individual cup of the blood of Christ.
- There you will take off your mask and consume the elements.

- Once you have consumed the elements and have readjusted your mask, use the hand sanitizer station as you return to your pew for prayer.
- The next person in line should not approach the pastor until this person is ready to go.
- Take your time. Safety and respect for the eucharist is most important.
- We will come forward by pew section at the direction of the ushers. The ushers will guide you to come forward using the center aisle, then you will return to your pew for prayer by the side aisle. Please be patient. Please be prayerful.




### New Adult Faith Formation Class Tuesday Evenings 6:30-7:30 pm at LCR May 18—June 29 A Good Old Age by Derek Prime
