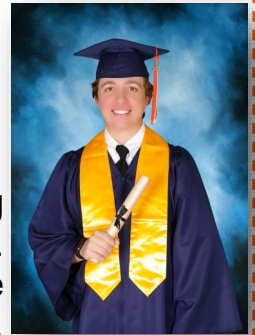

**AJ Evangelista** is graduating from North Springs High School. He will continue at Vanderbilt University.

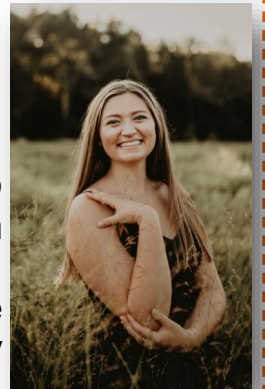


**Kevin Carey Kirwan III** is graduating from Wheeler High School. He will continue at University of Alabama, Birmingham.

is graduating from Wheeler Magnet. She will continue at University of Illinois, Urbana-Champaign

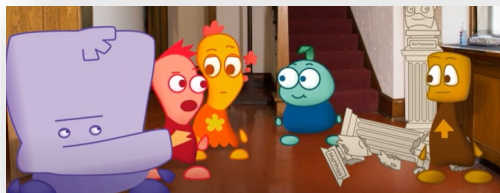


**Samuel James Thornton** is graduating from Walton High School and is reviewing his options.

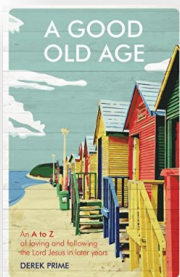
## Blood Drive at LCR Monday, May 17 from 4-8 pm

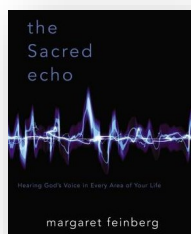
