This Sunday is Pentecost Sunday and as is our tradition at LCR, we invite everyone to wear red clothing. We wear red because it is the color of the fire of the Holy Spirit that was poured out on the church. We'll read the Acts 2 story this Sunday in worship!

Dear Members and Friends of LCR,

Throughout the COVID 19 pandemic LCR has been following the guidelines of the CDC and attempting to offer different worship options for all of us to consider. Because we are the body of Christ in the world, we are called by Jesus to care for and minister to the most vulnerable people among us.



In light of the CDC guidelines of last week, the Church Council voted unanimously at its May meeting to do, among things, the following:

Make the wearing of masks and social distancing optional for fully vaccinated people. This practice includes both the Parking Lot service and the Sanctuary service and goes into effect this Sunday, May 23.

Since the option of social distancing remains important to many members of LCR, we will continue to limit the number of people worshipping in the Sanctuary to 70 per service, and therefore ask that you make a <u>reservation</u> to come to 8:30 am Sanctuary worship during the preceding week.

Thank you for your continuing patience and understanding during this difficult time. Let us always remember that we model our lives after Jesus' life - the One who gave His life in service to others.

Dave for serving those in need.


