Council Update

Based on recent changes by the CDC on guidance for social distancing and use of face masks for fully vaccinated people and the continued improvement of the Covid matrix, the



continued improvement of the Covid matrix, the Council approved the following 3 motions at their May Council meeting:

- 1. Effective last Sunday, the use of masks and social distancing has been optional for fully vaccinated people.
- 2. Starting June 1, the Gathering Room will be open for church related functions and for fully vaccinated people the use of masks and social distancing is optional.
- 3. Beginning June 20, we will be offering 3 separate worship services in addition to live streaming online service:

8:00 am Sanctuary in-person worship 9:30 am Parking Lot worship

11:00 am Sanctuary in-person worship

12:00-1:00 pm Drive thru Holy Communion

Again, masks and social distancing is optional for fully vaccinated people at those services.

All services will be identical during the summer and Adult Faith Formation will be suspended during the summer to accommodate this schedule.

We anticipate returning to the pre-pandemic schedule after the summer.

Council approved these measures enthusiastically providing options to the congregation and, as we have over the duration of the pandemic, follow the guidelines by the CDC.

You will continue to make reservations to attend in person Sanctuary worship, so we can manage the number of people and provide social distancing to people who wish to do so.

Providing 4 worship services every single Sunday comes at a cost, the cost of need for many volunteers. If you are able to help in any way at one of our worship services, please reach out to any of the our staff members.
