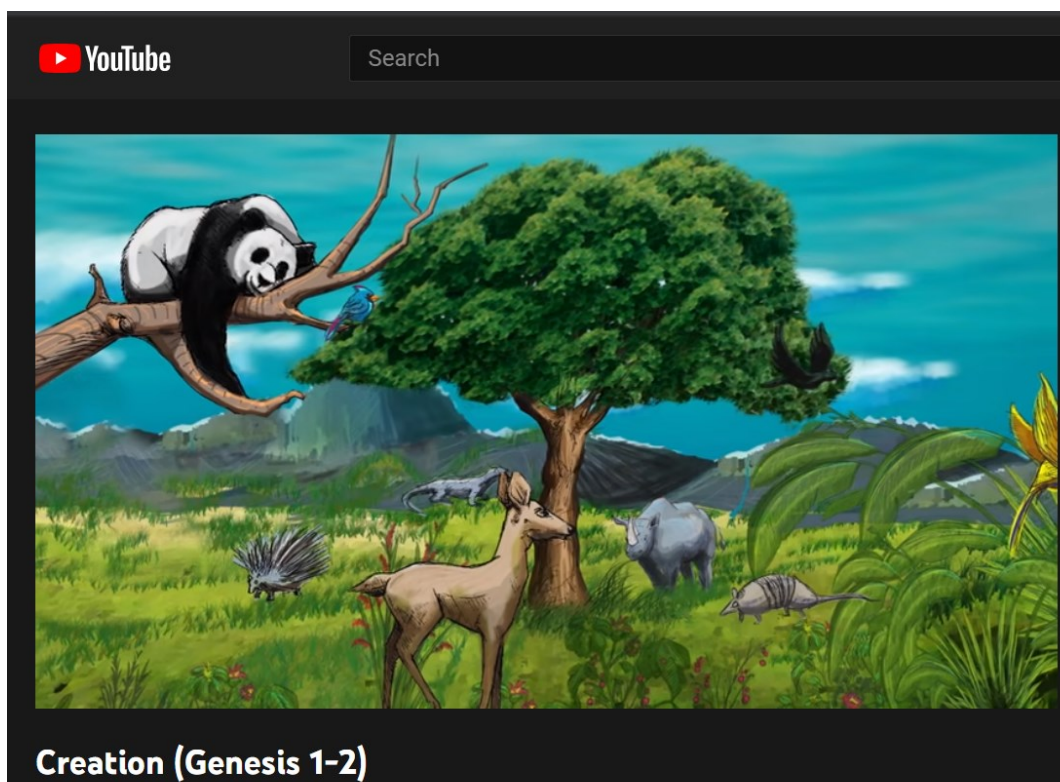


## Children

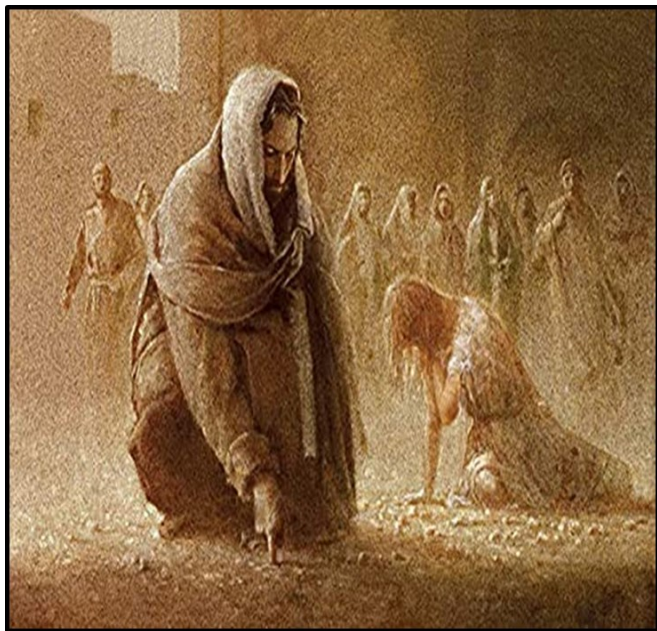
## MUST Food for Families Next Collection: Saturday, June 12, 2021

## Step off the Curb: Active Bystander Intervention Workshop offered June 12 in Kennesaw



Do you find it uncomfortable when you witness harm between people in public or even at your dining room table? Do you wonder what you should do? Stay silent? Speak up? Pretend it's not happening? Walk away? Get help? Intervene?

people who “got involved” when they witnessed harmful situations. Verbal abuse, harassment, racist comments, bullying behavior.
