The pandemic has greatly affected how we do ministry at LCR, most particularly in the area of worship. During it all the Council and staff have focused our efforts on providing as many options as possible. And now thankfully,



finally, Sanctuary worship is one of those options. We now have 2 options for Sanctuary worship: 8:00 am and 11:00 am. Since the pandemic continues to impact us in different ways, certain protocols have been put in place to enable us to worship in the Sanctuary while at the same time pay attention to the safety and wellbeing of all of our members. Let me review with you 4 of those protocols:

1. Social distancing and masks are optional for all fully vaccinated people:

If for any reason you want to wear a mask during any part of the service, please feel free to do so. And since all of us are not fully vaccinated, social distancing remains important. We are limiting the number of people in the sanctuary to 70 to accommodate that option.

2. Reservations are required to attend Sanctuary worship: It's easy. Just go to our website <u>(lcrmarietta.org)</u>, at the bottom of the page click on *In Person Worship* and *Reserve Your Space Here* and fill it in. If the 70 person maximum is reached, your other options are to sign up for the other Sanctuary service, come to Parking Lot worship at 9:30 am, worship in the parking lot during the Sanctuary service using the radio feed, or watching the worship service online.

3. Please follow ushers instructions:

Ushers will seat you as you enter the Sanctuary and invite you to leave the Sanctuary after worship is over starting from the back to the front.

4. Holy Communion is offered at both Sanctuary services:

We have developed a procedure to share Communion that we believe is safe and efficient. That procedure will continue to be explained at the beginning of the service. I will be wearing my mask during the sharing of Communion as an added precaution for my safety and yours.

Why are these protocols important? Because we are a Christian community, and we care for one another, especially the most vulnerable ones among us. Many children are not yet able..... Continued on page 4
