Hello LCR members & friends,

Your 2021-2022 Church Council had their first council meeting of the year on June 27th. I am very excited to be working with this talented group of faithful leaders as we continue to live out LCR's mission of deepening people's relationship with Jesus Christ and each other.



I am pleased to report that LCR ended our fiscal year on May 31 with a financial surplus of \$8,264! This is a wonderful blessing, and I am thankful to God for this, and very grateful for your continued financial support of our ministries. Your council voted to designate \$4,300 of this surplus to outreach and \$3,964 for the Youth Pavilion renovation project. It is a wonderful gift to be starting our new fiscal year in a strong financial position.

Worship continues to be a vibrant part of LCR, and we are all excited that we now offer two in-person worship services in addition to parking lot worship and on-line worship. Attendance has been consistent as we have made this major transition in our worship services over the past several weeks. Your staff and council continue to provide these worship options to the congregation, which comes at a great cost. I am thankful for all the volunteers who have stepped in to assist with the numerous tasks that are required to make worship happen. If you are able, I would ask you to consider volunteering for an aspect of worship. Feel free to reach out to one of the staff members to find out where you can help.

Our goal is to put together 124 stockings (100 for residents and 24 for each of the group home care givers). So we have a little ways to go. Your support is much appreciated.

Every year at Christmas time, elves from LCR bring filled stockings to special needs adults living in group homes in Cobb. This stocking is often the only gift the residents of the home receive. Half of the current residents are considered “orphans” as they have no family.


Worship Volunteers Needed
