The theme of this year's celebration is: Dreams for Our Daughters. The event is being held as a fundraiser to assist in the education and training of the young Mayan women at the Milagro Center. The Milagro Center and the Santisima Trinidad Lutheran Church, both on the campus of the Lutheran Center in Guatemala City, have been international partners with the Lutheran Church of the Resurrection for the past four years.

The Gala will be held on Saturday night, beginning at 7:00 pm, at the Atlanta Country Club in Marietta. There will be lots of opportunities to participate in various activities, experience Guatemalan culture and sweetbreads, spend time with Bishop Kevin Strickland of our Southeastern Synod, and, most importantly, hear the hopes and dreams for the children of not just Guatemalans but also of many American parents and grandparents.

The event will include a free t-shirt, appetizers and a cash bar. The cost is only \$40 per person, all the profit going to assist the Milagro Center in its mission. There will also be a raffle for a small quilt and a wall hanging made by the women of First United Lutheran Church, Kennesaw.

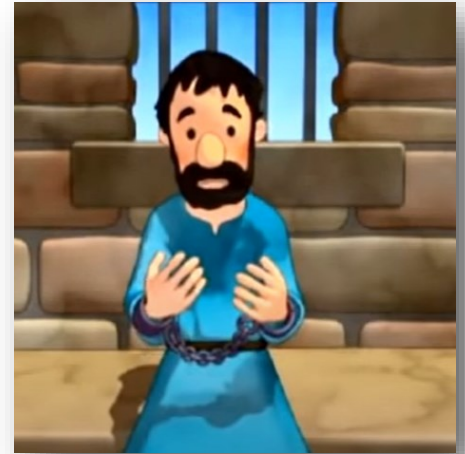
What is your good news? Share stories with your family about good news that you heard about or that happened to you by writing pretend news articles or creating colorful posters. See who can share their good news with the most excitement!
