Hi everyone!

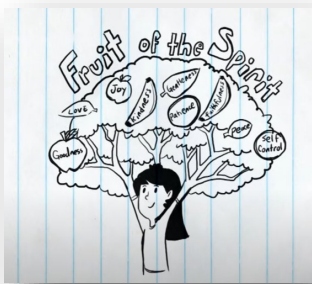
