Your council recently held our September meeting, and I would like to share a couple key highlights with you.

From a financial standpoint, through the first quarter of our fiscal year, LCR continues to be in a strong position. Income exceeds budgeted levels by \$4,700, and expenses are below budgeted levels by \$23,500. Note that some of this is timing related and expected to balance out over the course of the year.

We are a blessed congregation, and I am thankful to all of you for your continued financial support of our ministries.

Weekly worship continues to be a major component of living out the vision of LCR. Based on current Covid trends in our area, we will continue to offer multiple worship options, as well as continue with our Covid related protocols. In doing this, your council believes that this will enable us to care for all our brothers and sisters in Christ. Thank you for your cooperation and a big thank you to our dedicated staff and volunteers who make it possible to provide these types of vibrant worship options, as we live out our mission to deepen people's relationships with Jesus Christ and each other.

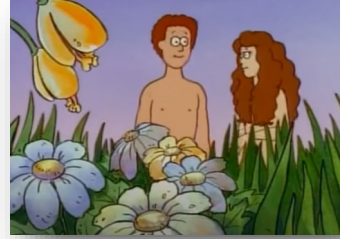

Praise Music & Worship

Worship.
