As a result, the following protocols will **go into effect this Sunday, January 9, and remain in effect for the month of January.** The Council will then reevaluate the situation and respond accordingly.

January Worship Times 2 Worship Services:

8:30 am Traditional Worship in the <u>Sanctuary</u> with masks and reservations <u>required</u>

11:00 am Contemporary Worship in the <u>parking lot</u> with masks required for communion.

Masks will be required for all indoor church activities throughout the week. Groups meeting at church are highly encouraged to meet via Zoom whenever possible.

These protocols are, in my judgement, a faithful effort to continue to offer choices for how we worship God at LCR, while at the same time honoring our high and holy calling to safeguard and protect the wellbeing of all of God's children, especially the most vulnerable among us. The number of COVID cases at LCR has never been higher. Each of us can do two things: pray for the healing of all and do what we can to ensure our own health and the health of those around us.


